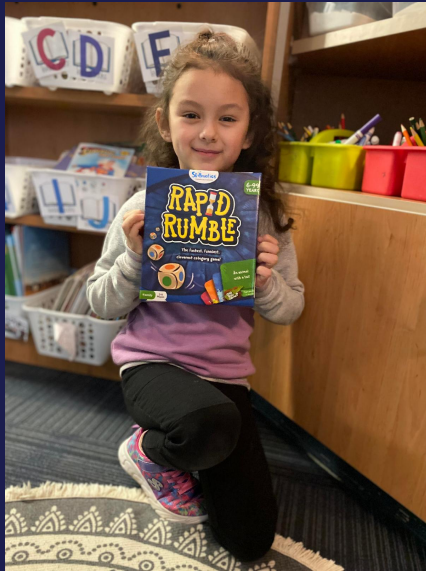




# South Bend Education Foundation
